












- ★ GET IN GEAR AND SIGN UP. Registration will end at 520 people or May 1, 2022 at midnight, whichever occurs first.
- **★ Location:** The event will be held in the mountains of Central Pennsylvania starting in the small town of Lock Haven located off I-80 approximately 3 hours driving distance from Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Rochester, NY, and Baltimore, MD.
- ★ Directions to Starting Point & Camping: Take Lock Haven Exit off Rt. 220. Proceed North through 2 stoplights. Turn right at next stop sign. Proceed 1 mile + and take first right after Piper Airport (follow red Dual Sport Arrows). GPS address for rider reception, camping, and start is 859 Lower Creek Road, Lock Haven, 17745.
