

- ★ GET IN GEAR AND SIGN UP. Registration will end at 520 people or May 1, 2023 at midnight, whichever occurs first.
- ★ Location: The event will be held in the mountains of Central Pennsylvania starting in the small town of Lock Haven located off I-80 approximately 3 hours driving distance from Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Rochester, NY, and Baltimore, MD.
- ★ Directions to Starting Point & Camping: Take Lock Haven Exit off Rt. 220. Proceed North through 2 stoplights. Turn right at next stop sign.
